Respond to 17-year-old Tupac Shakur

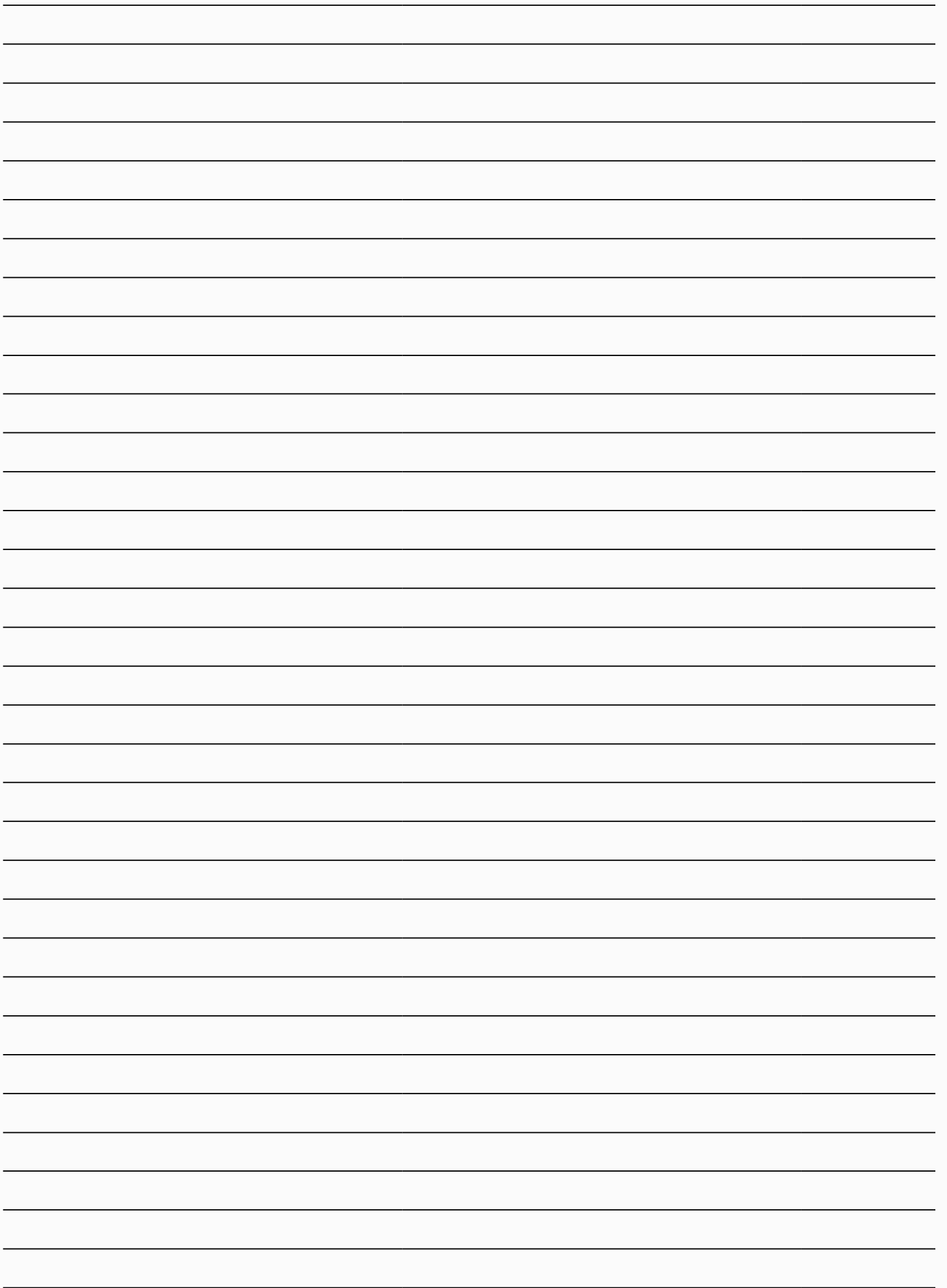
