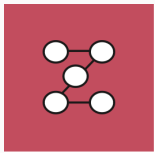
Language of The Discipline

Focuses on the specific vocabulary, terms, and expressions unique to a subject area.



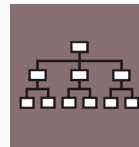
Details

Encourages paying attention to the specific facts, elements, and components within a topic.



Patterns

Looks for recurring elements, themes, sequences, or events within a topic.



Rules

Focuses on the guidelines, principles, and regulations that govern a topic.



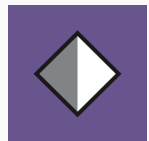
Multiple Perspectives

Considers different viewpoints or interpretations within a topic.



Over Time

Examines how a topic evolves or changes over a period.



Ethics

Investigates the moral implications or ethical issues related to a topic.



Big Idea

Identifies overarching themes, concepts, or ideas that connect different areas of knowledge.



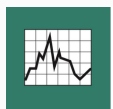
Unanswered Questions
