Adjectives

Adjectives are words that describe or give more information about nouns (which are people, places, things, or ideas). They help make sentences more interesting and detailed.

For example:

- In the sentence "The cat is fluffy," the word "fluffy" is an adjective because it describes the cat.
- In "She has a red balloon," "red" is the adjective that tells us the color of the balloon.
- In "The tall tree," "tall" is the adjective describing the height of the tree.
