Write About a View That Captivated You

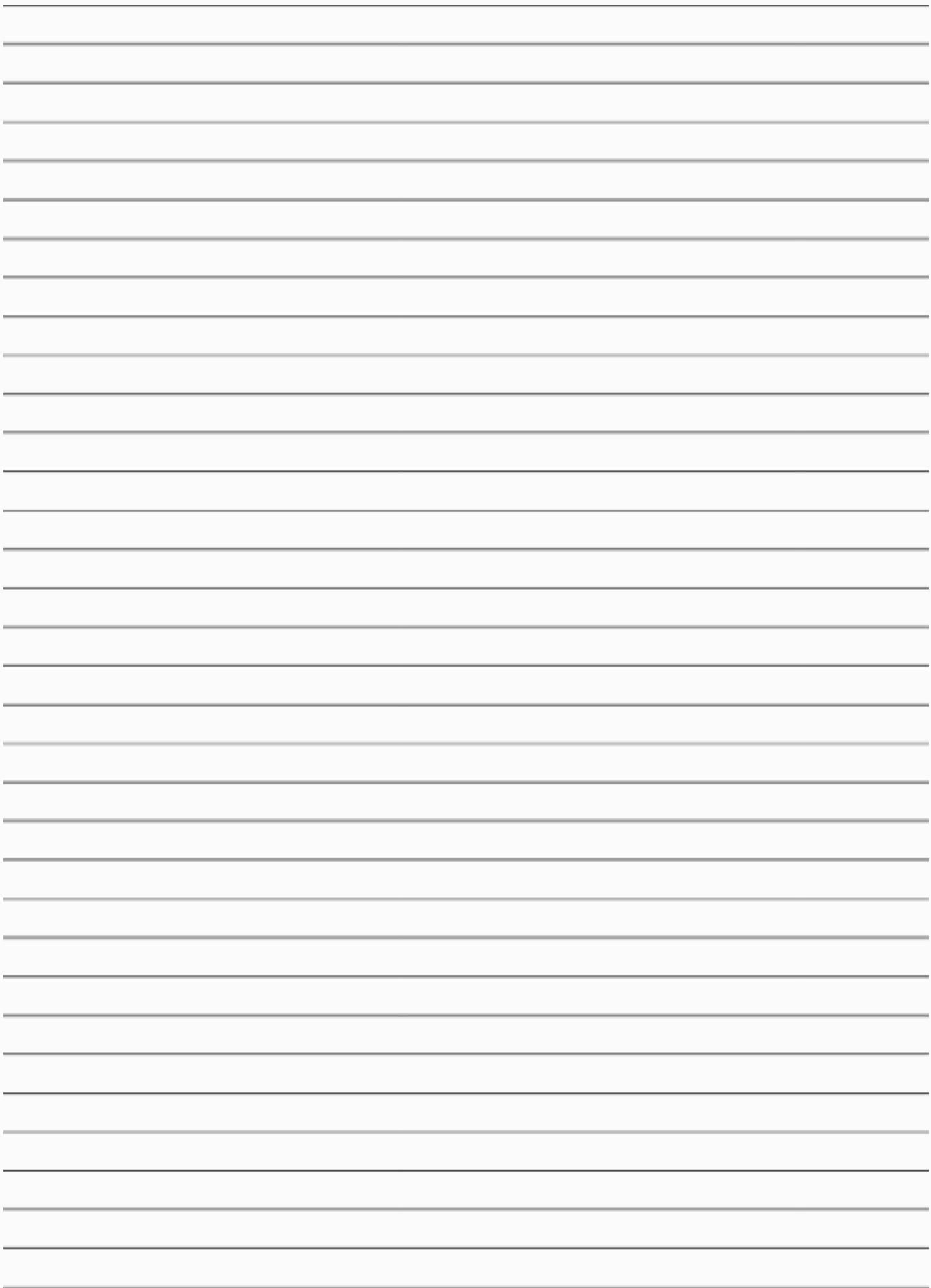
Write about a view that once captivated you. You know, a view that once filled you with serenity and wonder.
