Write a 10-sentence short story using irregular verbs in the simple past tense

Sentence 1 – Begin your story with “Yesterday...”

Sentence 2 – Use one of these irregular verbs: said, told, thought, or knew.

Sentence 3 – Use dialogue



Sentence 4 – Use one of these irregular verbs related to movement: arose, leapt, shrank, or strode

Sentence 5 – Use exactly 12 words.

Sentence 6 – Use one of these irregular verbs: kept, wore, met, or became.

Sentence 7 – Ask a question.



Sentence 8 – Include an animal.



Sentence 9 – Use one of these irregular verbs: tore, misheard, overcame, or swore.

Sentence 10: End your story with exactly 6 words.
