Sentence 1: Begin your story with a question.

Sentence 2: Include ONE of these adjectives: Fluffy, Obnoxious, Muscular, Mellow.

Sentence 3: Use personification (eg., "The sun smiled down on the flowers").

Sentence 4: Write a sentence with exactly 7 words.

Sentence 5: End the sentence with the word "turtle."

Sentences 6: Use a simile (eg., "The girl was busy as a bee").

Sentence 7: Use onomatopoeia (eg., buzz, clap, splash, achoo, knock)

Sentences 8: Include a reptile.

Sentence 9: Reference a celebrity.

Sentence 10: Finish the story with exactly 10 words.
