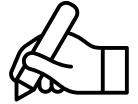

Your mission is to write a short story about anything you choose. But there's a twist—you must follow these specific guidelines for each sentence:

**Sentence 1:** Use exactly 5 words.



**Sentence 2:** Begin the sentence with “Although” and use between 16 and 20 words.

**Sentence 3:** Use exactly 3 words.



**Sentence 4:** Use between 10 and 13 words.

**Sentence 5:** Include an animal.



**Sentence 6:** Ask a question.

**Sentence 7:** Use exactly 6 words.

**Sentence 8:** Begin the sentence with “Since” and use at least 10 words.

**Sentence 9:** Use between 2 and 5 words.



**Sentence 10:** Finish your story with exactly 10 words.
