Example: The <u>b</u>razen <u>b</u>andits <u>b</u>arreled through the <u>b</u>ustling town.

Sentence 3: Begin with the letter **"C**" and include a **question**.

Sentence 4: Begin with the letter "**D**" and include a **number**.

Sentence 5: Begin with the letter **"E**" and include a **simile**.

• A simile compares two different things using the words "like" or "as."

Example: Each raindrop fell as softly <u>as</u> a whisper.

Sentence 6: Begin with the letter "F" and include dialogue.

Sentence 7: Begin the letter "**G**" and include a **sensory detail** (sight, sound, taste, touch, or smell).

Sentence 8: Begin with the letter "H" and include an emotion.

Sentence 9: Begin with the letter "I" and include the word "hero."

Sentence 10: Begin with the letter "J" and conclude the story.
