Writing Challenge: Use <u>Anaphora</u>, <u>Epistrophe</u> and <u>Anadiplosis</u> in a Paragraph



Repetition is a powerful tool for persuasion, emphasis, and rhythm in both writing and speech. Watch the video explanation, then write a paragraph that incorporates three forms of repetition: anaphora, epistrophe, and anadiplosis.

Anaphora - The repetition of a word or phrase at the beginning of successive clauses or sentences.

Example: We will rise. We will fight. We will overcome.

Epistrophe - The repetition of a word or phrase at the end of successive clauses or sentences.

Example: I want $\underline{\textbf{justice}}$. You deserve $\underline{\textbf{justice}}$. We demand $\underline{\textbf{justice}}$.

Anadiplosis - The repetition of the last word of one clause or sentence at the beginning of the next.

Example: Fear leads to <u>anger</u>. <u>Anger</u> leads to <u>hate.</u> <u>Hate</u> leads to suffering.

Example Paragraph

Determination drives success. **Determination** fuels progress. **Determination** builds <u>resilience</u>. Without <u>resilience</u>, there is no <u>growth</u>. Without <u>growth</u>, there is no <u>achievement</u>. Without <u>achievement</u>, there is no fulfillment. We strive for <u>fulfillment</u>. We work for <u>fulfillment</u>. We live for <u>fulfillment</u>.

Anaphora:

Determination drives success, **Determination** fuels progress, **Determination** builds resilience.

The word "Determination" is repeated at the beginning of successive sentences.

Anadiplosis: Determination builds <u>resilience.</u> Without <u>resilience,</u> there is no <u>growth.</u> Without <u>growth,</u> there is no <u>achievement.</u> Without <u>achievement.</u> There is no fulfillment."

The last word of each clause ("resilience" \rightarrow "growth" \rightarrow "achievement") is repeated at the beginning of the next.

Epistrophe (Repetition at the end):

We strive **for fulfillment**. We work **for fulfillment**. We live **for fulfillment**.

The phrase "for fulfillment" is repeated at the end of each sentence.

Write a paragraph that incorporates three forms of repetition: anaphora, epistrophe, and anadiplosis. Identity where you used each of these devices.
