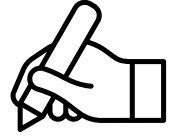

Creative Writing Challenge



Your mission is to write a short story about anything you choose. But there's a twist—you must follow these specific guidelines for each sentence:

Sentence 1: Include an amphibian (e.g. frog, salamander, newt, toad).



Sentence 2: Include the name of a country (e.g. China, Kenya, Argentina, France).

Sentence 3: Use ONE of these adjectives: nervous, pitiful, jealous, brave.

Sentence 4: Write a sentence with exactly seven words.

Sentence 5: Include a sport (e.g. soccer, basketball, tennis, cricket, ice hockey)



Sentences 6: Include alliteration.

Alliteration – Repetition of initial consonant sounds. (Peter Piper picked a peck of pickled peppers.)

Sentence 7: Ask a question.



Sentence 8: Include a type of weather (e.g. rain, snow, fog, hail, windy, blizzard).

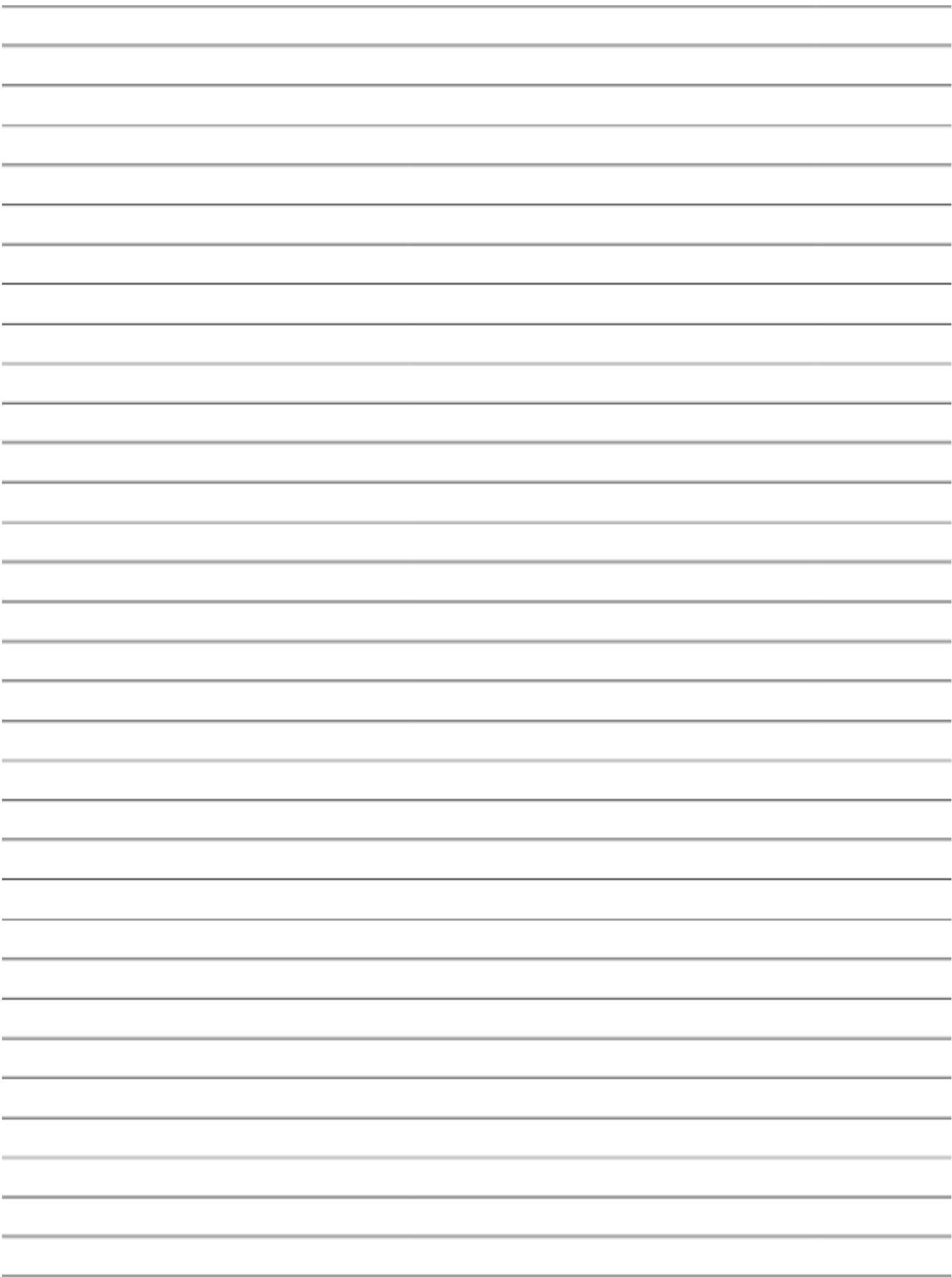
Sentence 9: Include a color (e.g. blue, brown, purple, red, green).

Sentence 10: Reveal a surprising detail.
