Sentence 5: The lemonade was cold.

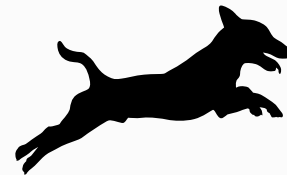
Sentence 6: The dog chased a squirrel

Sentence 8: The owner screamed.

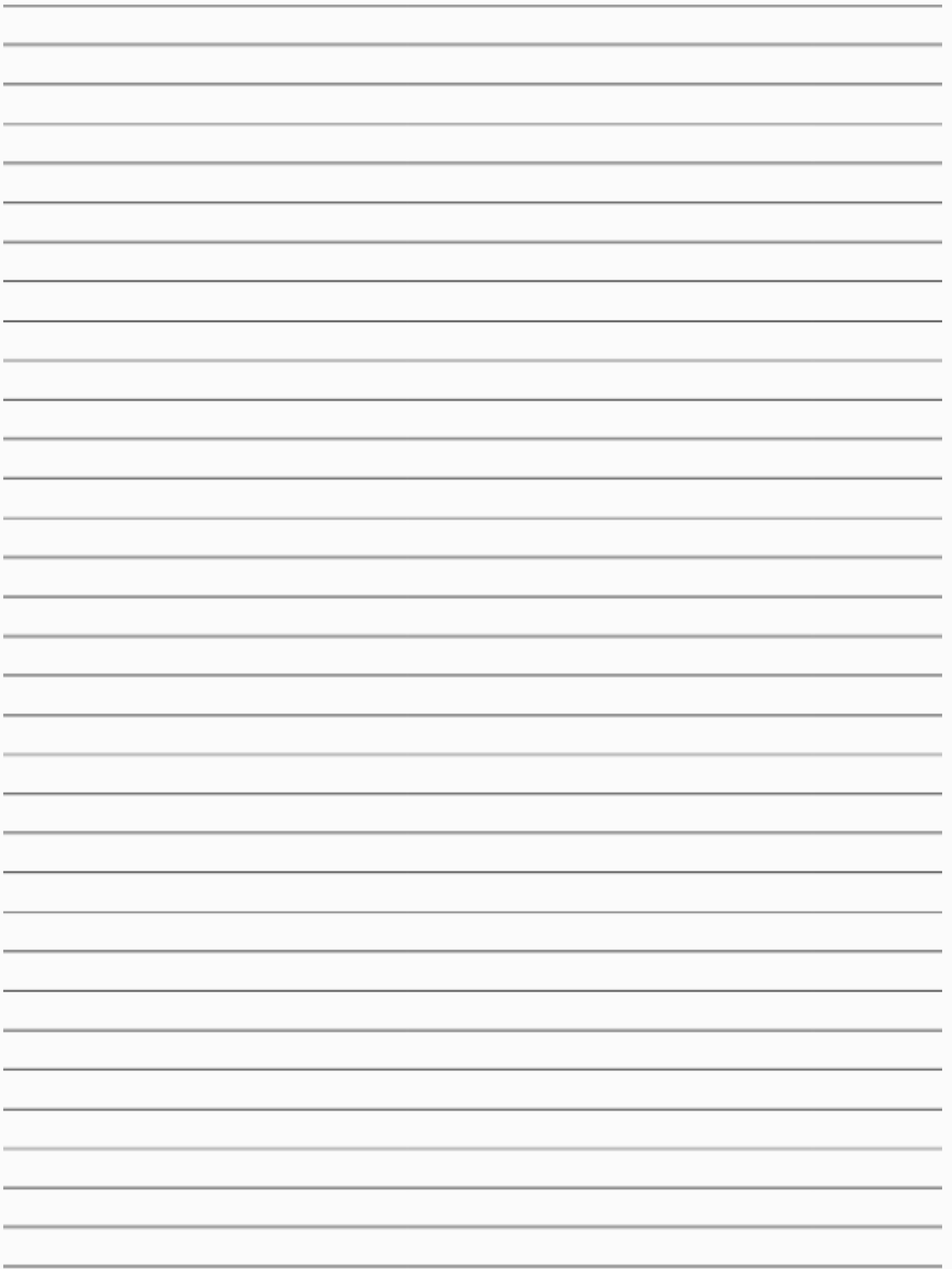
Sentence 9: The squirrel ran away
