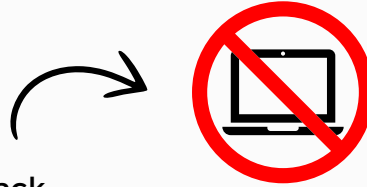

It's time for your test.

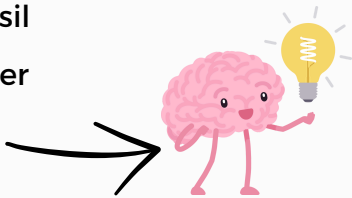
First things first:

- 💻 Place your computer in your backpack.

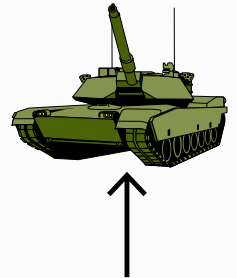


This test requires only three things:

- 🧠 Your memory



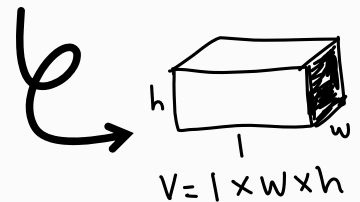
Your challenge? Demonstrate everything you've learned so far this year.

The goal is simple: Recall what you've learned and put it on paper.

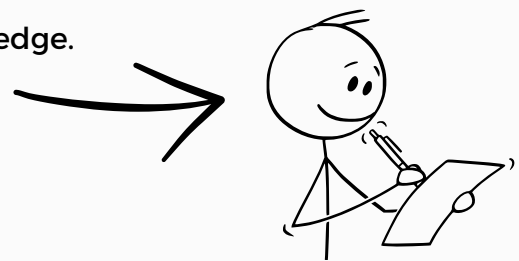


At first, you might feel stuck. That's normal. This is how learning works.
