Sentence 5; Include **dialogue** expressing **doubt** or **hesitation**.



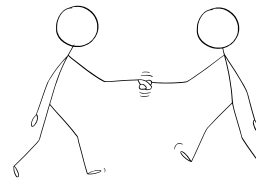
Sentence 6; Use one of these words: **betrayed, secret, loyalty, uncertain**.
