Sentence 1: Start with an action verb and introduce the character.

Example: Stumbling through tangled vines, Tina realized she was completely lost.

Sentence 2: Describe a **sound** heard in the jungle.

Example: A distant howl echoed through the trees, sharp and bone-chilling.

Sentence 3: Use a **metaphor** to describe the jungle.

Sentence 4: Introduce a **physical obstacle** the character must overcome.

Sentence 5: Include a line of dialogue.

Sentence 9: Mention an **object** the character finds or uses.

Example: At the base of a tree, she spotted a rusted compass half-buried in the dirt.

Sentence 10: End with a dramatic twist.

Example: When she looked up, she was the impossible.
