Write a 10-Sentence Story of Your School Year



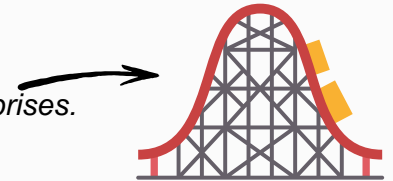
Write a short story about your school year. Be honest, creative, and reflective.

Sentence 5: Include **dialogue** that shows how you felt in that moment.

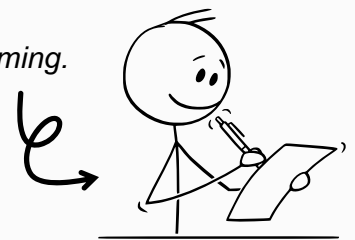
Example: "How am I supposed to do all of this?" I whispered to myself during a late-night study session.

Example: Even though some days felt impossible, I never gave up.

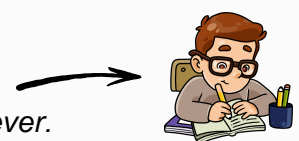


Sentence 9: Mention **someone** who has **helped** or **influenced** you.
