Sentence E: Use alliteration.

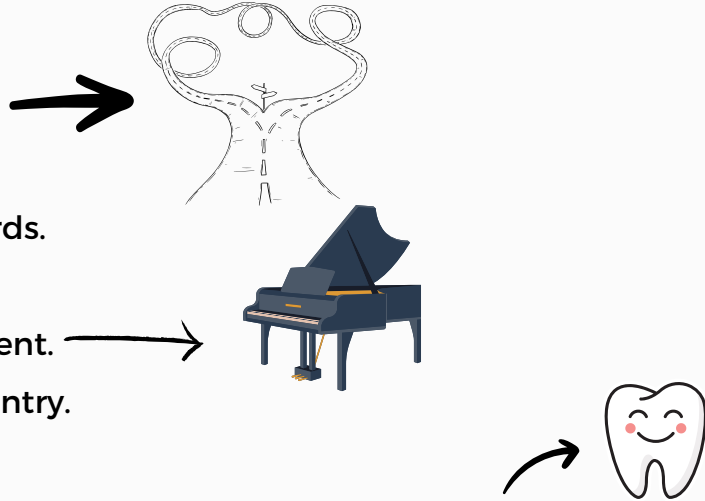
Sentence F: Include a musical instrument.
