Wild Ride: Creative Car Story Challenge



Write a 10-sentence story about a strange car. Each sentence must follow the rule below. Use your imagination, and don't be afraid to take risks.

Sentence 1) Start with a **Mystery**: Write a sentence that includes a **question** — something the character is wondering when they discover the car.

Example: Why would someone leave a car like this in the middle of the desert?

Sentence 2) Use contrast: Describe the car using one beautiful detail and one disturbing detail.

Example: Its silver paint sparkled like moonlight, but the tires oozed a black, sticky liquid.

Sentence 3) Create suspense: Use a short sentence (three to five words) that adds tension.

Example: Something was inside

Sentence 4) Use a line of **dialogue** that reveals more about the speaker's personality than the situation.

Example: I've always wanted to steal a car," she whispered, grinning.

Sentence 5) Include **movement**: Write a sentence where something moves in a surprising or unnatural way.

Example: The gearshift twitched like it had a pulse.

Sentence 6) Use a **metaphor or simile** to describe a **sound** the car makes.

Example: It roared to life like a sleeping dragon choking on smoke.

Sentence 7) Involve the **environment**: Describe how the setting reacts to the car.

Example: The grass shriveled under its tires as if afraid to touch it.

Sentence 8) Introduce a memory or flashback: Connect the car to something from the character's past.

Example: It smelled exactly like Grandpa's garage, thick with oil and secrets.

Sentence 9) Show internal conflict: Write a sentence that includes a contradictory feeling.

Example: She felt thrilled and terrified, like this moment could ruin or rescue her.

Sentence 10) End with a **transformation**: The car — or the character — changes in a strange, magical, or unexpected way.

Example: As he touched the steering wheel, his hands turned to chrome.
