## Write a 10-Sentence Love Story

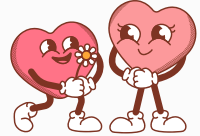
Write a 10-sentence short story about love using the structure below.

**Sentence 5:** Begin with **"Although..."**

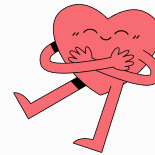
**Sentence 6:** Include a **sound word**:
