Vocabulary Options: eerie, pungent, vibrant, muffled, dazzling




Sentence 2: Introduce a **character using a vivid adjective**.

Sentence 3: Describe the **setting using at least one strong adjective**.

Vocabulary Options: desolate, cluttered, majestic, chaotic, overgrown



Sentence 4: Present a **problem, challenge, or unexpected situation**.

Vocabulary Options: dilemma, vanished, malfunction, intruder, crumbled

Sentence 5: Use a **metaphor or simile** to show how the **character feels**.

Vocabulary Options: burden, fury, panic, hope, tension



Sentence 6: Show your **character taking action**.

Vocabulary Options: sprinted, investigated, struggled, negotiated, escaped

Sentence 7: Add a **twist or surprise**.

Vocabulary Options: revealed, disguised, encrypted, eerie, betrayed



Sentence 8: Use **personification** to describe something non-human.

Vocabulary Options: shadows, clock, wind, flames, fog

Sentence 9: **Resolve the conflict or mystery**.

Vocabulary Options: discovered, reunited, solved, apologized, uncovered

Vocabulary Options: regret, courage, loyalty, transformation, purpose
