10-Sentence Story Challenge (Irregular Verbs)

Prompt: Your character walks into the classroom and sees something surprising.

Write a 10-sentence story using one irregular verb in the past tense in each sentence. Follow the sentence guide below to help you build your story.

Sentence 1) Start with a **surprise**: Show your character's shock.

→ Use an irregular past tense verb like: saw, heard, found, came



Sentence 2) Use a **feeling** or reaction word: Show your character's curiosity or confusion.


→ Use a verb like: felt, became, got

Sentence 3) Add a **simile**: Compare two things using like or as.

→ Use a verb like: thought, knew

Sentence 4) Describe the **setting**: Help the reader see the place.

→ Use a verb like: stood, went, sat




Sentence 5) Include **dialogue**: Have your character talk to someone.

→ Use a verb like: said, told, spoke

Sentence 6) Add an **action**: Make your character move or react.

→ Use a verb like: ran, took, hid




Sentence 7) Use another **irregular verb**:

→ Use a verb like: broke, gave, chose

Sentence 8) Add **suspense**: Build mystery or tension.

→ Use a verb like: kept, left, lost



Sentence 9) Reveal a **twist**: Show what really happened.

→ Use a verb like: came, brought, made

Sentence 10) End with a **feeling or thought**: How does your character feel now?

→ Use a verb like: felt, knew, understood
