10-Sentence Story Challenge: Metaphor Edition



Write a story consisting of 10 sentences. You must use at least 5 metaphors. Follow the sentence guidelines below:



Sentence 1: Begin with a description of your **character's emotional state**.

Example: "Noah was a volcano waiting to erupt."

Sentence 2: Introduce the **setting** with a strong **metaphor**.

Example: "The classroom was a pressure cooker on test day."



Sentence 3: Reveal what's causing **tension or emotion**.

Example: "He had forgotten to study for the biggest exam of the year."

Sentence 4: Describe a **key object** in the scene using **metaphor**.

Example: "His pencil was a lifeline dangling over a cliff."



Sentence 5: Show how the **character attempts to cope or take action**.

Example: "He dove into the questions like a soldier in enemy territory."




Sentence 6: Include **internal dialogue or thought**.

Example: "'I am a ship without a compass,' Noah thought as he flipped to the next page."

Sentence 7: Introduce **another character or element**.

Example: "Across the room, Ava was a machine—focused, steady, unstoppable."



Sentence 8: Create a **moment of doubt or difficulty**.

Example: "His confidence crumbled; he was a castle made of sand."



Sentence 9: **Resolve** the **situation**, or hint at **how things might change**.

Example: "By the end of the test, Noah wasn't a volcano anymore—he was smoke and quiet ash."

Sentence 10: End with a final **metaphor** that **reflects a lesson or change**.

Example: "He walked out of the classroom a little wiser, a student turned storm-chaser."
