Sentence 3: Describe a **favorite drink** (e.g. lemonade, hot chocolate, boba).

Sentence 4: Use the **name of a book or movie** you love.

Sentence 5: Mention a **sport or physical activity** you enjoy.

Sentence 6: Include your **favorite snack** (e.g. chips, fruit, cookies).

Sentence 7: Name a **song, artist, or band** you like.

Sentence 8: Mention a **place you like to go** (e.g. a park, mall, beach, bookstore).

Sentence 9: Include a **number that is special to you** (e.g. birthday, lucky number).

Sentence 10: End the story with a **wish** (something you'd love to come true).
