Sentence 1: Use a **color** as your entire sentence.

Sentence 3: Ask a **question**.

Sentence 4: Include a **simile** using “like” or “as.”

Sentence 5: Mention an **animal** doing something **unexpected**.


Sentence 6: Start with “**Nobody knew.**”

Sentence 7: Use exactly **6 words**.

Sentence 8: Start with “**Even though.**”

Sentence 9: Use a **sentence fragment**.
