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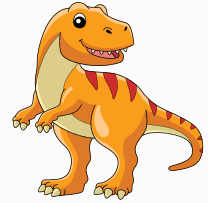
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Sentence Structure Challenge: Trapped in Dino Territory



Objective: Write a 10-sentence story that follows the sentence structure pattern below. Even though each sentence follows a different rule, your story should flow like a real adventure.

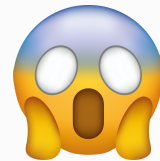
Writing Prompt: Your character gets separated from their group during a tour of Jurassic Park—and hears something huge moving in the trees.

Sentence 1: Begin with an onomatopoeia to set the scene.

Example: “Snap!”

Sentence 2: Include a **rhyme** somewhere inside the sentence.

Example: “He froze in fear when he heard it near.”



Sentence 3: Use a **dash** to show a sudden thought or surprise.

Example: “The ground shook—it was coming closer.”

Sentence 4: Begin with “**Maybe...**” to create mystery or doubt.

Example: “Maybe he could hide behind the bushes.”



Sentence 5: Use **alliteration**.

Example: “Big branches bent beneath the beast.”

Sentence 6: Include a **Simile or Metaphor**:

Example: “His legs felt like jelly.”



Sentence 7: Use a **colon** to introduce something.

Example: “He had only one choice: run.”

Sentence 8: Include a **question**.

Example: “This path led back to camp, didn’t it?”



Sentence 9: Write in the **Passive Voice**.

Example: “The trees were trampled by something massive.”

Sentence 10: **Repeat** a word or phrase for effect.

Example: “Don’t look back, don’t look back, don’t look back.”
