10-Sentence Story Challenge: Preposition Edition



Write a story in exactly 10 sentences.
Each sentence must follow the rule given.
Be creative, funny, or mysterious—whatever you like!



Sentence 1: Begin your story with **“Under my bed,”** and describe what you found.

Example: **Under my bed,** I found a small, glowing box covered in dust.

Sentence 2: Include a **preposition** that **shows location** (behind, beside, between, etc.).

Example: I knelt **beside** it, wondering if it was safe to touch.

Sentence 3: Use a **preposition** that **shows time** (before, during, after, etc.).

Example: **Before** I could open it, something inside began to rattle.

Sentence 4: Begin with **“Inside,”** and describe something **surprising**.

Example: **Inside,** a tiny green lizard with golden eyes blinked at me.



Sentence 5: Include a **prepositional phrase** that tells where **something is happening** (on the roof, in the hallway, etc.).

Example: It leaped **onto the floor** and scurried **under the dresser**.

Sentence 6: Use a **prepositional phrase** that tells when **something happened** (at midnight, during lunch, etc.).

Example: **During the thunderstorm** outside, the box began to glow again.

Sentence 7: Begin with **“Across the room,”** and add **some action or dialogue**.

Example: **Across the room,** my cat hissed and puffed up like a balloon.



Sentence 8: Use at least **two prepositions** in your sentence (under the table, beside the door, etc.).

Example: The lizard darted **between** my shoes and **behind** the curtains.

Sentence 9: Begin with **“Without,”** and show how your character reacts to something missing.

Example: **Without** thinking, I grabbed my flashlight and followed.

Sentence 10: End your story with a **prepositional phrase** (under the stars, in the distance, on the porch, etc.).

Example: When the light went out, I was standing **in the middle of a secret tunnel**.
