Use your creativity to write a compelling argumentative paragraph by following the instructions below.

Sentence 1 — Bold Claim:

Start with a strong and specific claim about your chosen topic.



Sentence 2 — Vivid Metaphor or Simile:

Compare your topic to something unexpected to make your point more memorable.

(Example: "Allowing phones in class is like opening a window during a storm—everything becomes chaotic.")

Sentence 3 — Evidence #1:

Give a factual piece of evidence from a reliable source, observation, or text.

Sentence 4 — Reasoning #1:

Explain why this evidence supports your claim.



Sentences 5 and 6 — Mini-Story (Micro-Narrative):

Tell a 1–2 sentence story or quick scenario that illustrates your point.

Sentence 7 — Evidence #2:

Add another piece of evidence that clearly supports your argument.

Sentence 8 — Analogy or Comparison:

Compare your argument to something from everyday life to make it easier to understand.

Sentence 9 — Counterargument:

Explain one thoughtful reason someone might disagree with you.



Sentence 10 — Creative Rebuttal:

Refute that counterargument using creative logic, a strong example, or a clever comparison.

Sentence 11 — Powerful Close:

End with a memorable final sentence—use a call to action, a punchy image, or a powerful restatement of your claim.
