## Irregular Verb Story Challenge (Simple Past Edition)



Your mission is to write a short story about anything you want, but each sentence must follow the rule listed. Every sentence must use simple past tense, and each required verb must be an irregular verb.

**Sentence 1:** Use exactly **6 words** and include the irregular verb “went.”

**Sentence 2:** Include the irregular verb “**saw**” and write **10–14 words**.

**Sentence 3:** Begin with “**Although**” and include the irregular verb “**felt**.”

**Sentence 4:** Use exactly **4 words** and include the irregular verb “**kept**.”

**Sentence 5:** Write a sentence that includes **two different irregular verbs** of your choice.

**Sentence 6:** Ask a “**why did**” question using an irregular verb (e.g., “Why did you take...?”)

**Sentence 7:** Include **dialogue** that contains an irregular verb (e.g., said, told, held, made, etc.)

**Sentence 8:** Begin with “**Before**” and use the irregular verb “**found**.”

**Sentence 9:** Use a sentence with an **irregular verb** and an **onomatopoeia**.

**Sentence 10:** End with a sentence that includes an **irregular verb** and a **surprising twist**.
