In this activity, you will reflect on the school year through a structured 10-sentence challenge. Your goal is to capture the funniest, strangest, hardest, and most meaningful parts of the year.

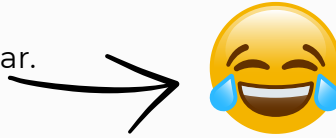
Sentence 1:

Begin with this exact sentence starter:

When I think about this school year 10 years from now, this is what I think I'll remember...

Sentence 2:

Describe a funny memory from the school year.



Sentence 3:

Describe a struggle or difficult moment you experienced this year.

Sentence 4:

Mention one person who made an impact on your school year.

This could be a friend, teacher, coach, or classmate.



Sentence 5:

Describe an unexpected moment from the school year. Something surprising, weird, chaotic, awkward, unbelievable, or unforgettable.

Sentence 6:

Describe something you learned about yourself this year.



Sentence 7:

Describe a moment that felt important, even if it seemed small at the time.

Sentence 8:

Describe something you will NOT miss about this school year.



Sentence 9:

Describe something you think you actually might miss one day.

Sentence 10:

Your final sentence must begin with:

"What I still don't know is..."



Example

- 1) When I think about this school year 10 years from now, this is what I think I'll remember...
- 2) I'll remember the day Greg got so excited that he won trivia that he jumped into the window and broke it.
- 3) I'll remember struggling to stay focused during the second semester when I was tired all the time and stressed about grades.
- 4) I'll remember my friend Daniel constantly reminding me to stop overthinking everything before tests.
- 5) I'll remember the random moment the projector stopped working and our teacher had to teach using only the whiteboard like it was 1997.
- 6) I learned this year that I'm actually more capable than I thought when I stop procrastinating and just start.
- 7) One moment that felt small at the time but now feels important was everyone clapping after our presentations because it felt like we survived something together.
- 8) I definitely will not miss waking up early or hearing "put your phones away" every five minutes.
- 9) But honestly, I think I'll miss seeing the same people every day and laughing about dumb things during class.
- 10) What I still don't know is whether I will make the football team next year.
